- The library provides a range of collections of books and other media to suit the requirements and interests of the Wodonga community in regard to information, leisure and life-long learning;
- Library staff selects materials appropriate to a wide range of information needs and interests. Materials that are of a specialised, academic or technical nature are generally not included in the collection;
- Library staff select materials for inclusion in the collection within budgetary guideline;
- The library will abide by federal and state authorities in terms of censorship;
- Library members under 16 years of age join with the approval and signature of a parent or guardian. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian to make a final decision on what is suitable material for the individual child or young adult;
- Formats selected will take into account the most widely available technologies, current and anticipated usage;
- Publishing trends and market availability may influence choice of material and format;
- The library will accept donations in good condition. Where not required in the collection, these may be offered in regular book sales and revenue raised will be used to purchase new items;
- The collections are subject to ongoing evaluation by qualified staff in respect of usage, currency, relevance and physical conditions; and
- Materials will be withdrawn from the collections when they are no longer required.
